INDONESIAN PLANNED PARENTHOOD ASSOCIATION (IPPA)

- **Dr Sarsanto Wibisono Sarwono**, the past Chairperson of Indonesian Planned Parenthood Association (IPPA). He had represented IPPA at ESEAOR Regional Councils and on several occasions represented the Indonesian Government in meetings at the United Nations in New York, specifically the Commission on Population and Development. He passed away on 30 September 2020.
- **Mr Jamaludin Falah**, IT Officer of IPPA Head Office and was the key staff in developing Clinical Management Information System (CMIS) for all IPPA Branches. Mr Falah passed away on 5 August 2019.

- **Dr M. N. Guha Majumder** is the Founder Chairman of Sarawak Family Planning Association (SFPA) Sibu Branch in 1964. He chaired the SFPA Council from 1970-1974; SFPA Honorary Advisor from 1975-2017 and Vice-President of the Federation of Reproductive Health Associations of Malaysia from 1979-1980. He was an Observer with the Regional Council, IPPF South East & Oceania and appointed by IPPF Central Office as a member of the Ad-hoc Committee on Work Programme & Budget in 1984-1985. Dr Majumder passed away on 3 June 2020.
- **Ms Kim Lau Kung Ming** served in the Sarawak Family Planning Association Miri Branch from 1988 - 2007. She headed the management of the urban-based office, which offered mobile clinics to serve the rural marginalized communities and plantations with her nursing specialization. She retired in 2007. Ms Kim Lau passed away on 13 July 2020.

- **Mrs B.P. Chopra** passed away on 22 August 2020 at the age of 85 years. She was one of the Founder and Life Member since the inception of the Perlis State Family Planning Association in 1962. An ExCo Member from 1962 – 1992.
